## Call for Research Study Participants

# Improving the Survivorship Care of African-American Women with Breast Cancer



We invite **African-American women** who are breast cancer survivors, at least 25 years of age, one year post primary treatment, involved in cancer advocacy and who previously participated in a research study to participate in a study as *Peer Navigators*

### Study participation will involve:

- 1) Enrolling in a study focusing on follow-up care and Survivorship Care Plan
- 2) Being trained as a *Peer Navigator*. Completion of 2 *all-day* trainings at City of Hope
- 3) Completing 2 brief surveys
- 4) Over a 3-year time frame, the Peer Navigator will navigate a total of 10-12 breast cancer survivors to obtain a Survivorship Care Plan. For each survivor navigated, the Peer Navigator will meet with the survivor for 5 times during a 6-month period.

Your participation is voluntary, and all information will be kept strictly confidential. You will receive \$100 upon completion of the *Peer Navigator* training and may receive up to \$100 for each survivor that you successfully navigate.
